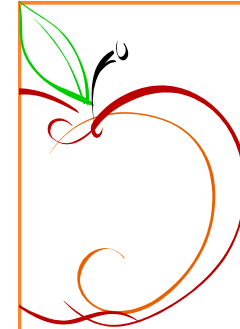

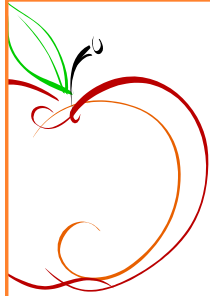

# Alexander Technique in the Big Apple

ACAT's week-long Summer Intensive
